Strong ties to Arizona's 1st Congressional District or the state of Arizona are preferred, but all students are encouraged to apply. Priority is given to current college students, although recent high school graduates with outstanding credentials will be considered during the summer term. College credits are available per school requirements.

- General administrative duties
